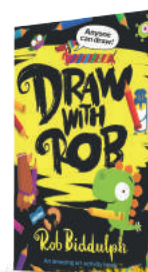

# DRAW WITH ROB

## How to DRAW...

# Gregosaurus



**1** First, draw a very simple U shape at the bottom of your page, slightly right of centre.



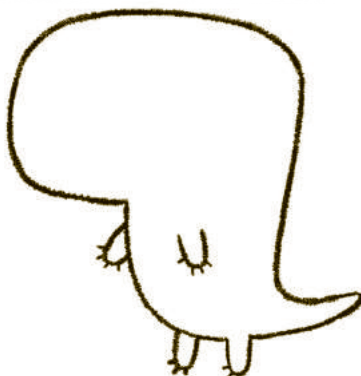
**2** Next, from the top left of your U shape, draw a curved line out and upwards.



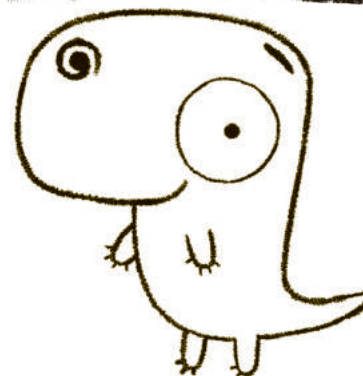
**3** Make a sharp left before heading up again, then curve around to the right and head back over the top.



**4** Then head back towards where you started. Before you get there go right for a small uphill detour. Then make a u-turn and head home.



**5** Draw in another U shape at the bottom, to the left. Now he has legs! Add two more, as shown, for Greg's hands. Don't forget his claws.



**6** In the middle of his head, draw a big circle with a dot in the middle. Add a line for an eyebrow, a curve for a smile and a swirl for his nostril. Hello, Greg!



**7** Now add his back plates. Start with a big diamond shape on top of his head, with three lines in it. Draw six more all the way down his back, getting smaller as you go.



**8** Draw four small spikes on Greg's tail. Add in small circles and dots along his back, below the back plates, to give his skin a nice texture.



**9** And it's time to colour in! My Gregosaurus is green and orange, but nobody really knows what colour dinosaurs were so use whatever colours you like.
